SCHOOL COMPETITIONS AND GUIDELINES

1st to 3rd December 2022

GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Participants must always carry their school identity card with them.
2. Registration must be completed before 9:30 a.m. on the day of the competition.
3. There won't be any registration fees for school students.
4. One teacher or parent from each school may serve as the team manager.
5. It is the duty of each participant to enquire about the time schedule of the competitions from our website, www.sjccmelange.com and report on time.
6. Participants must carry their school identity cards and badges, given at the time of registration and must produce the same on demand.
7. The judges' decisions are definitive in terms of competitions and results. The administration and arrangements will be decided by the organising committee, and their decision is final.
8. The committee has the right to make any changes in the schedule, venue, or guidelines if circumstances demand.
9. If the number of entries or participants for any event is not more than three, certificates and points will be awarded only on the basis of the grades obtained for the performances. In such cases, the organising committee has the right to decide on the prize money.
10. Without prior approval, banners, hoardings, flexes, and other similar items are not permitted inside the venue.
11. No gyrating, catcalling, or howling is permitted. Any improper or disruptive behaviour or violation of college rules may result in the cancellation of prizes, the team's disqualification, or the loss of points.
12. Rules of each event have to be strictly followed. For any details or clarification regarding the rules contact the event in-charge of each event between 9:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
13. Photography is not allowed at the venues.
14. The artworks created by the participants will not be returned, and the organisers (SJCC) reserve the right to use them.

COLLAGE

(1st PRIZE: ₹3,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹2,000/-)

1. Each team must have two members.
2. Participants are required to carry their school ID card.
3. The topic for the collage will be given on the spot.
4. Time limit for making the collage is 1½ hour.
5. Each team must submit a one-page write-up on the theme of their collage, neatly written in A4 size paper, along with the names of all participants and the institute.
6. No mobile or Internet access would be permitted during the competition.
7. The institute will only provide chart papers. Participants are required to bring supplies such as paper, magazines, glue, scissors, sketch pens, coloured pencils etc.
8. A team may be disqualified if it exceeds the time limit, deviates from the theme, or provides an inadequate explanation to the jury.
9. The decision of the judge is final and binding.

REELS

(1st PRIZE: ₹3,000/- and 2nd PRIZE: ₹2,000/-)

1. This is an individual event.
2. Reels should be between 20 and 30 seconds long.
3. Participants are required to carry their school ID card.
4. The topic for the REELS will be announced at the venue.
5. The video output should be in mp4 format with a 9:16 aspect ratio (portrait).
6. Only single entries are allowed.
7. Please make sure to include music in the reel.
8. The reel must be original, creative, and without any watermarks.
9. Content that is indecent or offensive will be automatically disqualified.
10. The final submission of the film must be in person, and the rushes should be produced if demanded by the jury.
11. The decision of the judge is final and binding.
